EVIG Service and Maintenance

Maintaining your EVIG is key to make sure of its performance now and in the future. A well-kept vehicle will last longer and perform better than a vehicle without service and maintenance. Here is a guide to keep your EVIG in good condition.

By following these steps, you will not only prolong the life of your vehicle, but you will also get a safer and more enjoyable driving experience. Take care of your EVIG and it will take care of you.

Battery

The battery is one of the most important parts of EVIG. Keeping the battery in a good condition is extremely important for EVIGS performance now and in the future. Here are some key points for keeping the battery in a good condition.

Try to keep EVIG charged between 20 and 80 percent at all times.

Maintenance Charging for Extended Parking

If you plan to leave your EVIG parked for a prolonged period it is important to maintain the battery health by charging it for 2 hours each month. This periodic maintenance charging prevents battery degradation that can occur when the vehicle is not in regular use.

Long-Term Parking

Before placing your EVIG in long-term parking charge the battery to at least 70% of its capacity. This initial charge level is crucial for maintaining the battery health over extended periods of non-use. Additionally, to preserve the battery's condition, continue to perform a maintenance charge for 2 hours every month during the long-term parking period.

Tires

Keeping a good tire pressure is very important for an easy and secure ride. Wrong tire pressure will affect EVIGS range and safety. Therefore, always make sure that the tire pressure is according to the *Tire and loading information* shown on your vehicle.

Brakes

Keeping the brakes in good condition is extremely important to ensure the safety of EVIG. This includes the parking brake, which will ensure that EVIG does not move when parked.

EVIG is each equipped with a drum break on all wheels. The foot pedal activates all brakes simultaneously making sure you will have full brake power in all conditions.

Make sure to check the brakes and the parking brake on the yearly inspection according to the manual.

Lights

All lights on EVIG are LED making sure that you will have great visibility both day and night at the lowest consumption. The position lights are always on making EVIG clearly visible by other drivers. During nighttime you can use both half beam and full beam fully enhancing the power of LED lights.

Remember to check the lights regularly making sure that they work as intended. Turn indicator lights and brake lights have sensors indicating if any light is broken. In this case the information will be shown on the dashboard.

Solar roof

Evig is equipped with a solar roof for support charging while on the go. It is important to keep the solar roof clean for it to perform as intended. This because dirt and dust will affect its performance negatively.

To clean the solar roof, use a gentle glass cleaner and a wipe made for a glass surface.

Cleaning

To keep EVIG clean is not only for it to look good. Gravel and dirt can lead to unnecessary abrasion. Use a gentle cleaner suited for electric vehicles.

The windshield of EVIG can be cleaned by using washer fluid. To add washer fluid, open the lid located on the left side of the dashboard and fill the tank.

Service and inspections

Electric vehicles do not need as much maintenance and service as a non-electric vehicle. They do however need some service and maintenance. It is important to follow the manufacturers service plan. This to make sure to spot potential problems before they get serious.
